How ICT can help Transformation

- 1-1 Pupil to ICT Ratio
 - A learner waiting for a PC is not enabled
 - > Enable flexible learning
- Remove false barriers to appropriate resource
 - > Ability to run applications irrespective of platform
- Remove ICT management workload from Teachers
 - > Fixing ICT problems is not best use of their skills
- Provide Access to a learners PLE, wherever they are, on whatever device they have to hand
 - > Embrace usage of phones, PDAs, etc
- Keep Data Secure
 - No discs in the post, no USB sticks left on the bus, disable ICT bullying
- Bring the World's resources to our Learners
 - Keep control of access, in and outbound



Big Issues for BSF

Affordability

- Initial Installation Costs
- > Lifetime Costs

Inclusion / Accessibility

- Inequality of delivery dependant on Wave = Two (or more) speed Users
- Accessible from all devices

Future Risk

ICT market changes – ie Web 2.0, Google, Open Source, etc

Security

Data & equipment

Sustainability

> Lifetime Environmental Impact of solution

Sun's BSF Goals

- Provide Most affordable ICT
 - ICT that reduces building costs
 - > Remove Refresh Imperative
- Provide Universal Access
 - ICT access for all wherever & whenever needed
 - Centralised provision makes whole authority roll out easier
 - Parity of provision to schools irrespective of Wave they are in
- Remove Future Risk
 - > Delivery of all platforms (Microsoft, Open Source, Web 2.0 etc)
- Top Level Security
 - Data kept inside
 - Equipment unattractive to thieves
- "Earth Friendly" ICT
 - > Minimal Lifetime Carbon Footprint
- Build a Delivery Team with sufficient Capacity
 - > Partnering with world-sized organisations

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Reflections on Competitive Dialogue Process

- Keep it a Dialogue
 - Develop the solution together
- Benefits of cohesion between ICT, Architects, Builders, FM etc
 - Many potential Benefits need an holistic approach
 - Does increase amount of work in process but reduces work after FC
- Keep Focused on whole Transformation not just Buildings
- Process requires significant resource from authority
 - > Resource needs to be properly skilled
- Non-Slippage in timescales difficult
 - Prioritising of BSF work is key








BSF Phase 1






Phase 1 & 2






Phase 1, 2 & 3






The Managed Learning Environment
